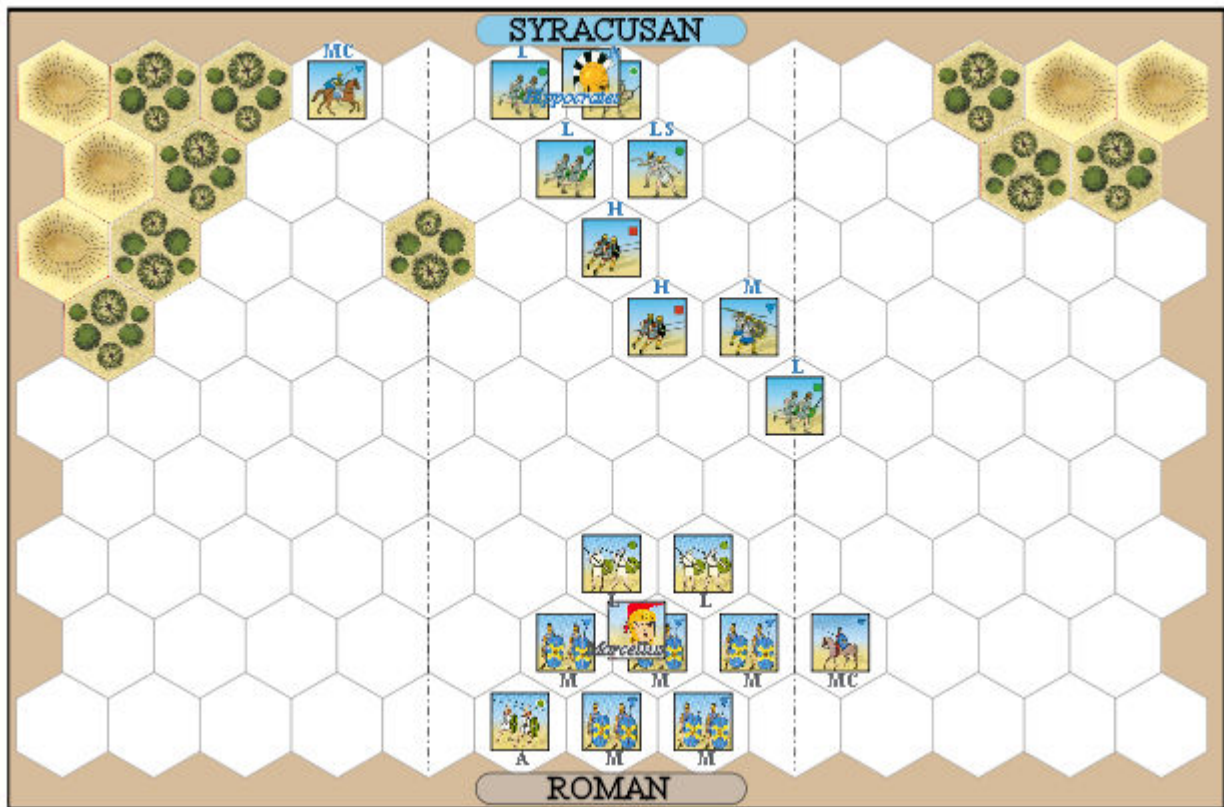


ACRILLAE - 213 BC



Historical Background

Hippocrates, with an army of 10000 foot and 500 horse, slipped through a Roman blockade and took the road to Agrigentum. He was unaware that Marcellus and his legion were arriving via the same road. Marcellus deployed quickly and attacked. Hippocrates and his army offered some resistance, but were eventually routed and only the cavalry was able to flee.

War Council

Roman Army

Leader: Marcellus

- Take 5 Command cards.
- Move first.

Syracusan Army (*Greek blocks*)

Leader: Hippocrates

- Take 2* Command cards.

Victory

1. 4 Banners

Special Rules

1. Syracusan army uses Greek (blue) blocks.
2. When a player plays a card that is designated specifically for either right or left section, he must define whether it will be applied to left, right, or center, as he sees fit.
3. *The Syracusan player starts with 2 command cards. On turn 1 he plays one card and draws two cards. Syracusan player hand size stays at 3 command cards for the rest of the battle.
